On-the Job Hazards - Residential ASL

- Vehicles (Parked and moving)
- Mailboxes
- Trees
- Wires
- Pedestrians
- Customer too close to container
- Miss placement of container
- Animals (mean dogs)
- Operating in dark hours



On-the Job Hazards - Residential RL

- Vehicles (parked and moving)
- Helpers in the right position (rear camera a must)
- Clear communication with helpers and driver
- Lifting techniques
- Objects getting into eyes
- Snakes or Vermin
- Stepping on and off truck
- High traffic roads
- Big picture



On-the Job Hazards - Commercial FEL

- Wires
- Trees
- Structures (Enclosure gates/Doors/Buildings)
- Backing
- Rolling out containers
- Vehicles (parked and moving)
- Pedestrians
- Confined/Tight spaces



On-the Job Hazards - Commercial Roll-off

- Vehicles (parked and moving)
- Overhead obstructions (wires, trees, etc.)
- Hoses
- Overloaded containers
- Containers loaded unevenly
- Pedestrians



Best Practices - Shawn Clark 2017 Top Gun

- Always be mindful of the surroundings
- Think two steps ahead
- Always have an out
- Be prepared for “what if”
- Never put yourself into a potential bad situation



Best Practices - Ernest Young 2018 Top Gun

- Head on a swivel
- Always be alert of surroundings
- Safety of others around you comes first
- Big picture
- Keep distractions to a minimum
