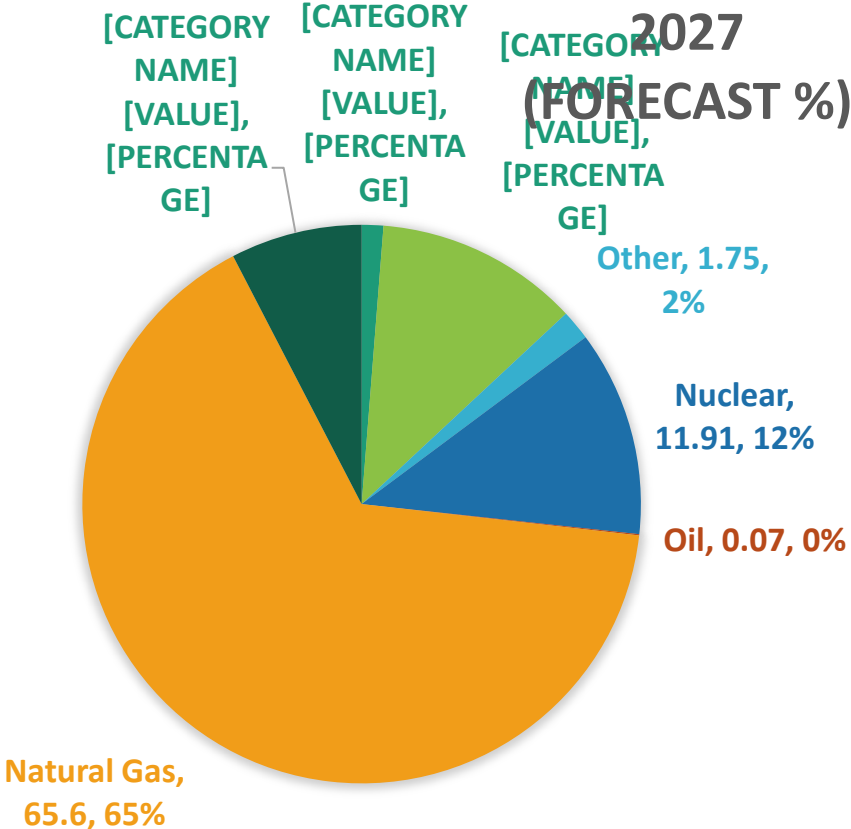
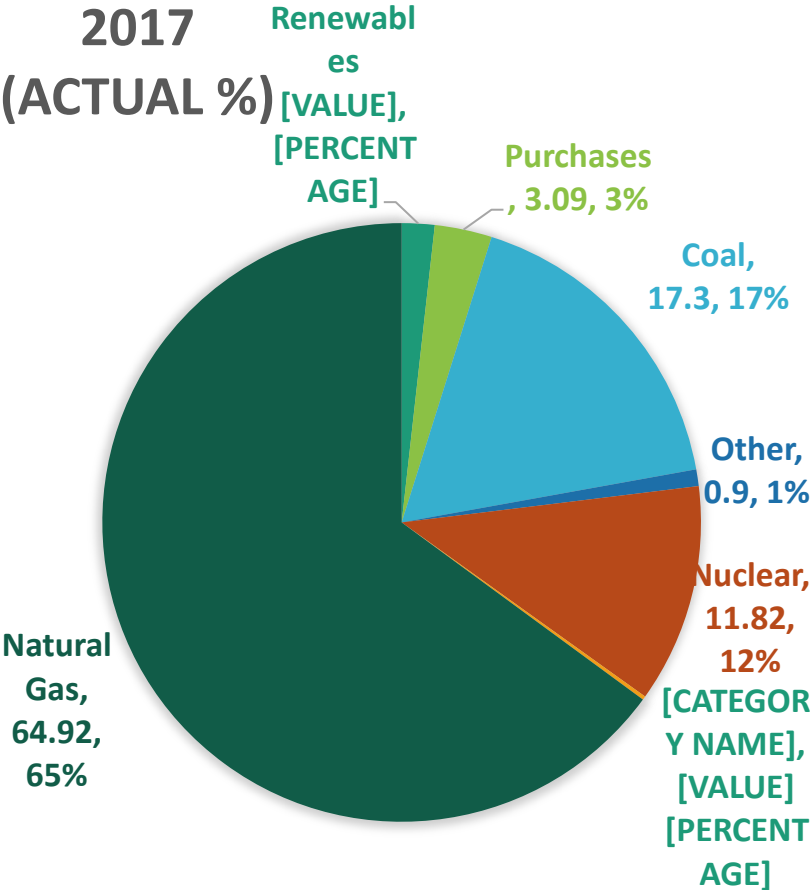
Engaging in outreach activities that provide ongoing professional development and promote improved regulatory policy and infrastructure management (e.g. in-country training and university collaborations)

Florida Public Service Commissioner

- 5-member board 4-year terms
- 3 term maximum
- Nominees selected by a Nominating Council
 - Qualifications based on knowledge and experience in fields such as accounting, economics, energy, engineering, finance, natural resource conservation, public affairs and law
- Appointed by Governor
- Confirmed by the Senate



Florida Energy Generation by Fuel Type

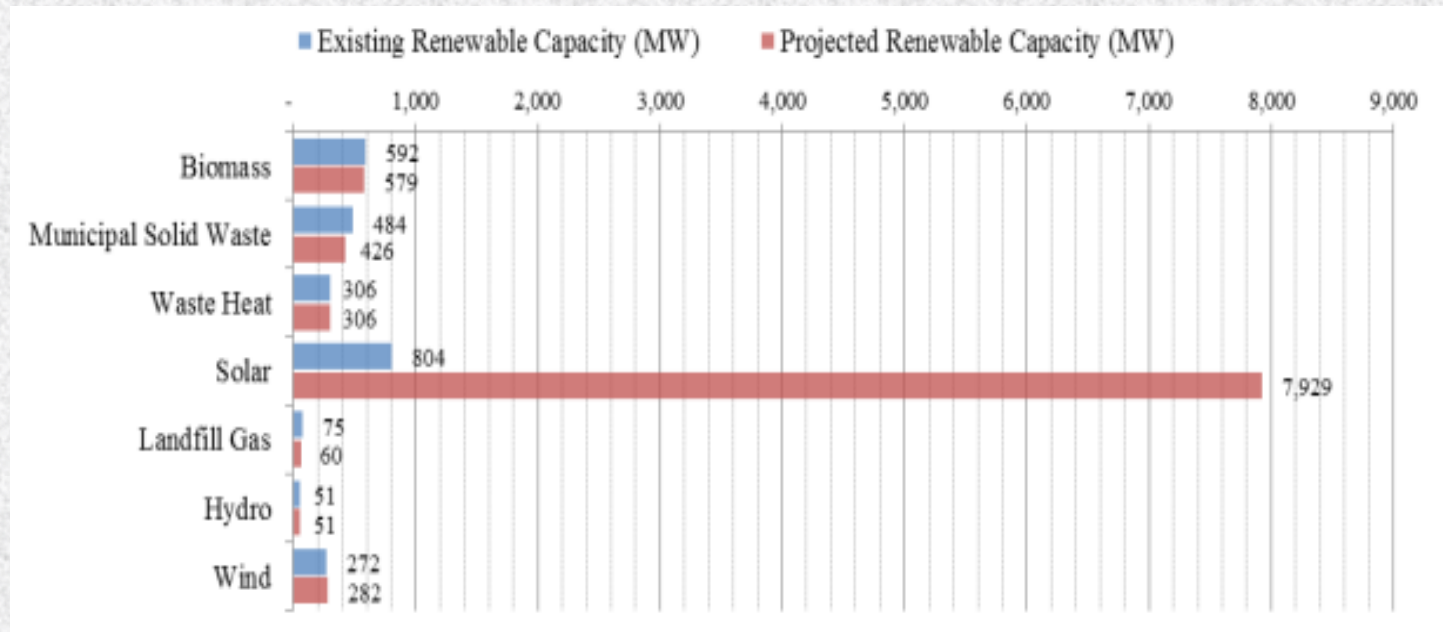


State of Florida – Existing Renewable Resources

Renewable Type	MW	% Total
Solar	804	31.1%
Biomass	592	22.9%
Municipal Solid Waste	484	18.7%
Waste Heat	306	11.8%
Wind*	272	10.5%
Landfill Gas	75	2.9%
Hydro	51	2.0%
Renewable Total	2,583	100.0%
